

STERLING CAPITAL FUNDS (f/k/a BB&T FUNDS)
TAX-EXEMPT INCOME INFORMATION
CALENDAR YEAR 2010

Certain states do not tax mutual fund dividends derived from interest on their own obligations. However, they may tax dividends derived from interest on obligations of other states. The table below shows the percentage of exempt-interest dividends derived from each state or territory. To determine the amount which may be exempt from state income tax, (1) add together the total amount of income dividends and short-term capital gain dividends you received during 2010 as reported on your account statements, (2) subtract the amount reported in box 1a of Form 1099-DIV from the amount determined in (1) above, and (3) multiply the result by the percentage shown in the table below for your state or territory.
